The Director of Small Savings, Group Insurance & Institutional Finance, Government of Tripura has given clarification through their memorandum No.F.12(1)-GIS/2016/1724(A), Dt 02-07-2016, about the admissibility for enrollment as a member of Tripura State Government Employees' Group Insurance Scheme, 1983.

In the above memorandum at para-2, the Director of Small Savings, Group Insurance & Institutional Finance, Government of Tripura has clearly opined that as per provision of para 4.1 of Tripura State Government Employees' Group Insurance Scheme, 1983, it is compulsory for all those employees to be enrolled as a member of this scheme who enters the state Government service after the Scheme is notified if the service are regularized subsequently.

Besides, in compliance with the Finance Department's U.O. No-201/FIN(G)/2016, Dt-26-05-2016, it has been stated that, those employees who were appointed as fixed payee in the School Education Department and got regular scale of pay after completion of 5 (Five) years of service with concurrence of the Finance Department, would be admissible to become a member of Tripura State Government Employees' Group Insurance Scheme, 1983, subject to final decision of the appeal lying in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in respect of Education Department.

In view of above, all the HO & DDOs under this Directorate are hereby asked to follow the instructions accordingly.
